

Arkansas Outdoor School Summer Day Camp 2021 protocols

The following protocols are put in place to match recommendations from the Arkansas Department of Health, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and the University of Arkansas System Division of Agriculture. Procedures may be updated based on current ADH, CDC, and UADA recommendations.

COVID-19 procedures:

- All staff and campers will be screened for symptoms of COVID-19 daily before camp utilizing a standard COVID survey.
- Daily temperature checks will be taken at the beginning of the day.
- Facilities will be cleaned thoroughly before each day of camp.
- Higher usage areas will be cleaned after use.
- Groups will have designated indoor gathering areas where others will not go.
- Parents will check-in and check-out students outside of buildings in a designated area.
- Social Distancing will be encouraged.
- Campers 10 years or older will be encouraged to wear a mask when social distancing is not possible.
- Staff members will wear masks when social distancing is not possible.
- There will be designated hand washing and hand sanitizing times.
- Personal items and camper lunches will be stored in assigned individual containers.
- No sharing of lunches will be allowed.
- Campers will drink out of individual water bottles. Water fountains will not be allowed.
- Outdoor activities that naturally support social distancing will be emphasized.

In the event of a sick student

- Individuals displaying symptoms will be isolated from the remaining campers.
- Parents/guardians will be immediately notified and required to pick the student up.
- Individuals displaying COVID-19 symptoms will not be allowed to return to camp without written permission from a doctor.
