## AOS Adventure Day Covid-19 Procedures

In response to the Covid-19 pandemic, we have put the following procedures in place to reduce the risk of infection and/or spreading the virus.

- Daily Covid-19 symptom screening and temperature checks of all campers and staff at check-in
- Camper check-in will happen outside
- Campers will be divided into groups called “Cohorts” with no more than 9 campers per cohort
- Cohorts will have separate check-in / pick-up areas, gathering areas, and use separate restrooms
- Campers will stay in their cohorts and not mix with other groups and are encouraged to practice social distancing within their cohort
- When needed, equipment will be assigned to individual campers
- No sharing of lunches, snacks or personal belongings such as water bottles or beach towels
- Campers need to bring their own food and water bottles
- Camp buildings and equipment will be cleaned before the start of every day, with high usage areas cleaned after use
- Campers 10 years or older will be encouraged to wear a mask when possible
- Staff members will wear masks
- There will be designated hand washing and hand sanitizing times
- Camper items will be stored in individual containers
- Outdoor activities that naturally support social distancing will be emphasized

### In the event of a sick Camper

- Campers displaying symptoms will be isolated from the remaining campers
- Parents/guardians will be immediately notified and required to pick up their camper
- Campers displaying COVID-19 symptoms will not be allowed to return to camp without written permission from a doctor
