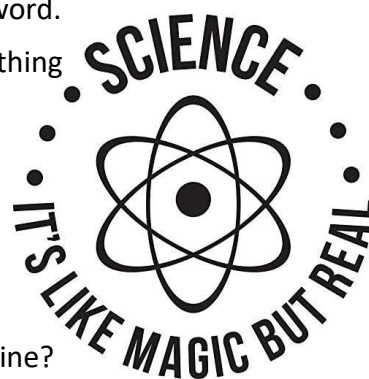




7th and 8th Grade
